Our two children (13 and 18 years old) have been very recently granted spots to study abroad (in France) from September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 and will be relocated to France with my wife. I will be moving to a service apartment before being relocated out of Hong Kong for work in a few months. As a result, I will not need a domestic helper's service any longer nor be able to provide her with any accommodation.

Miss Liwliwa Ermitanio Gamboa is a very trustworthy person who remarkably works and behaves. She has been working in Hong Kong for 12 years, spent 10 years with her previous employer.

She never broke a contract, her previous employers neither.

If our family situation would have not changed, we would have been very happy to keep her working with us.

We would like her to be able to start working with her new employer as soon as possible, without being requested to go back to the Philippines.

Given the sanitary situation in the Philippines, and the difficulties for her to go back there if ever she had to (only few flights, risk to be infected, few quarantine spaces back in Hong Kong, the high price to pay for such a trip), I respectfully request your understanding to allow her to be able to stay in Hong Kong and start working with a new employer right away.
